Carilion Giles Community Hospital and the Medical Executive Committee recognize the importance of medical education and the incredible potential of tomorrow's medical professionals. Therefore, we will be rewarding scholarships for the 2020-21 school year. Enclosed you will find a scholarship application with requirements that should be provided to each applicant.

Carilion Giles Community Hospital Medical Staff Scholarships are available to students pursuing a course of study in the field of medicine. This includes those studying to become a doctor, nurse, physical therapist, anesthesiologist, radiologist, or other medical fields. One applicant for a \$500 scholarship award will be selected at each of the following schools: Giles High School, Narrows High School and James Monroe High School. One applicant for a \$1,000 scholarship award will be selected from Southwest Virginia Governor's School.

To be eligible for this scholarship, each applicant MUST:

- Be from Giles or Monroe County
- Be entering a medical field
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
- Have completed one biology course and at least one other science course related to a medical career (chemistry, physics, etc)
- Complete the application in its entirety
- Attach a complete transcript
- Include SAT or ACT with a breakdown of scores from their counselor
- Write a short essay explaining why this scholarship is beneficial to you pursuing a career in medicine, and what person or event inspired you for choosing this career.

Applications are due by **April 21, 2020** or at least **3 weeks prior to awards ceremonies** to allow for processing time by the Medical Executive Committee and Carilion Clinic. Please mail completed applications and all required information to:
