Failure to meet the deadline will **ELIMINATE** you from consideration .

3. Take time to present impressive applications (i.e. neat, typed or printed). Read the questions on the applications and compose a rough draft response BEFORE entering it on the actual form.
4. You will use your current GPA for your scholarship applications. Your GPA will be given to you with your requested applications. You can also find your GPA on PowerSchool.
5. Applications and requirements for each scholarship are based on information provided by each organization. Although we do contact EVERY organization each year to confirm the availability and conditions of their scholarship, we do not always hear back from them. **Therefore, there is a possibility that some listed scholarships may NOT be available this year.**
6. Most of the scholarships will be awarded after the successful completion of the first semester of college. Some scholarships require that you have enrolled for your 2nd semester of study. The recipients will be announced at the Awards Assembly. Most scholarships have a time limit and must be used within one year of graduation.
7. OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS – Some additional scholarships may be available that have not yet been finalized. Be sure to fill out the GENERAL APPLICATION and put “Additional Scholarships” under the Scholarship Name section.

PLEASE respond with “THANK YOU” notes if you receive any scholarships. In addition to thanking the organization for selecting you, thank them for having a scholarship available to NHS graduates. Please see Mrs. Buckland in the office for names and addresses for notes.

- Preference given to applicants planning to attend a 4 year college
- Majoring in education with special preference to those majoring in mathematics

- Award of \$1,000 for a Narrows High School student

Celanese Math & Science Scholarship

- Award of \$1,000 to be given to either a Narrows High School OR a Giles High School student

Class of 1970 Memorial Scholarship

- One award of \$TBD (*unconfirmed amount*)
- Recipient must be strong in traits which exemplify high moral character
- Recipient shall be sensitive to opportunities to render unselfish service and assistance to others

Class of 1972 General Scholarship Fund

- One award of \$500+ (*unconfirmed amount*)
- Recipient must be strong in traits which exemplify high moral character.
- Recipient shall be sensitive to opportunities to render unselfish service and assistance to others, to his/her school, and to his/her community

Class of 1974 General Scholarship Fund

- One award of \$TBD (*unconfirmed amount*)
- Recipient must have participated in high school extracurricular activities.

Class of 1980 General Scholarship Fund

- Two awards of \$125 (*unconfirmed amount*)
- Recipient must be strong in traits which exemplify high moral character
- Recipient shall be sensitive to opportunities to render unselfish service and assistance to others, to his/her school, and to his/her community

Giles County Farm Bureau

- One award \$500
- High school senior
- Intent to earn a degree in agriculture or natural resources

Giles Education Association Scholarship

- One award of \$300
- Awarded to a senior who plans to become a teacher

Grace Robertson Memorial Scholarship Alpha Delta Kappa

- One award of \$300
- Recipients must be pursuing a career as a teacher to be considered
- Have an overall grade point average of 2.9 or higher

The Jarrett Lane Memorial Scholarship

- One award of \$1,000
- A minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- School Community and/ or Church Activities that contribute to making the applicant well-rounded
- Two recommendations from employers, teachers, and/ or ministers or other church officials that are unrelated to the candidate

Nano Sonic, Inc.

- One award of \$500
- This scholarship will be awarded to a college or trade school bound senior.
- Special consideration will be given to students majoring in science or technology.
- A secondary preference will be given based on need

Narrows Junior Women's Club Scholarship

- Two awards, one for \$600, one for \$500 (Jean Wheeler Scholarship)
- Student shall submit a letter to the Narrows Junior Woman's club stating
 - Vocational Goals
 - School and/or Vocational related activities, past and present
 - Any relevant personal remarks
- Student should be accepted to an institution for advanced educations (college, university, business or vocational school)
- Student should be ranked in the top 25% or his/her graduating class
- Special leadership qualities and initiative to seek part-time employment are desirable, but not required

Narrows Rose Garden Club

- One award of \$250
- Preference given to a student with an interest in pursuing further education in agriculture or horticulture.

Pearisburg Junior Woman's Club General Scholarship

- One award of \$300

Phyllis Blevins Greer Memorial Scholarship

- One award of \$500

Rich Creek Lion's Club

- Two awards of \$1,000

Rich Creek Lion's Club – Votech student

- One award of \$1,000 (obtained through VoTech)

R.M. & E.H. Ingram Charitable Trust

- One award of an unconfirmed amount (\$500+)
- Priority given to students with disabilities

VFW Auxiliary Scholarship

- One award of \$200
- Highest consideration given if a family member has served in the military
- Criteria: scholastic achievement, character, potential for success

Wolf Creek Ruritan Club

- Three awards of \$600 (*unconfirmed amount*)
- Students must write a double spaced paper on the following question:
 - What are your immediate plans for college after graduation?
